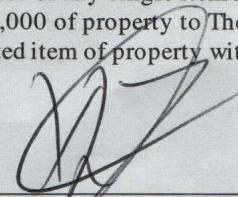

"Valuations of Gifts in Kind are the privilege and responsibility of the donor. A Salvation Army Valuation Guide for fair market value will be supplied on request. Contributions are deductible for Income Tax purposes to the extent allowed by law."

**"NOTE:** Due to the record keeping and reporting requirements imposed by the Internal Revenue Service, The Salvation Army requests all donors who will require the Salvation Army to execute a Form 8283, 'Noncash Charitable Contributions', for contributions over \$5,000 to present such forms for execution at the time of the donation. The Salvation Army will not be able to execute such forms at any time thereafter if the donated property cannot be traced. The Salvation Army is required to report to the Internal Revenue Service the sales proceeds of any single item in the event (a) the donor claimed a deduction of more than \$500.00 for the item, (b) the donor contributed more than \$5,000 of property to The Salvation Army in the year the single item was contributed, and (c) The Salvation Army disposes of such contributed item of property within three years of its receipt of the property."
